BCU 3 White Water Kayak Assessment

With Steve Banks

Overview: This one day course is the assessment for the new (2007) 3 star White Water Kayak award. Holders of this award have demonstrated the skills and knowledge to be effective members of a led group on open water with winds up to Force 3, as well as simple moving water. This award is a prerequisite for 4 Star White Water Kayak training.

Content: Candidates will need to demonstrate appropriate personal paddling skills, safety & rescue skills, leadership, group awareness and underpinning theoretical knowledge. Please check the BCU website for a full syllabus.

The assessment will be conducted via task setting, observation and discussion in a friendly and supportive atmosphere.

Prerequisites: Candidates must be at an appropriate standard for assessment, ideally they will have completed 3 star training. Evidence must be provided of:
At least 3 different open water journeys of a minimum of 3 hours
A minimum of one 3 hour session in an alternative discipline

Cost and date: As advertised

Venue: Practical work will take place in local South Cumbrian venues.

Course times: 9am to approximately 5pm

Equipment: Candidates should be aware of the equipment required for this award and it will be assumed this is so. If you have any questions or difficulties with this element please do not hesitate to contact Steve, he will do his best to assist.
