



BCU 4 Star White Water Kayak Training Course

With Steve Banks

Overview

This course comprises the training element of the BCU 4 Star White Water Kayak Leader award. There are significant alterations to this qualification; not least that it is now a leadership award in its own right. Holders of the new 4 Star certificate will now be qualified to lead groups of up to 4 competent others on moderate inland waters (i.e. rivers up to grade 2, exposed open water with wind up to force 4) – this is a big difference to the previous version in which the requirement was to be competent to be in such a led group. It is also hoped that this award will act as a much more effective progression to the 5 star qualification. Please note that this is not a coaching award and is not deemed suitable by the BCU for introducing beginners to the sport. 4 Star is a prerequisite for UKCC Level 3 Coach training and the new BCU Moderate Water Endorsement.

Content

The 2 day course will cover the following elements:

Personal paddling

Leadership and group organisation

Boat set up and appropriate equipment

Safety and rescue (this element is also covered in the separate BCU WW Safety & Rescue course which you must attend before assessment).
